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INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES



The route:

From the assembly point at the Port Lincoln Primary School on Lincoln Place,
Turn left onto Mortlock Terrace
Turn left at Liverpool Street (roundabout),
Turn right onto Light St (KFC roundabout),
Turn right onto Tasman Terrace,
Turn right onto Blich Street (Grand Tasman roundabout),
Continue past roundabout onto Mortlock Terrace and back to the Port Lincoln Primary School Oval.

1. The entry number you are given is for judging only, you will be advised just prior to the procession of your actual position in the procession. The Marshalls decision on position is final.
2. All registration forms must be returned **before 3pm Friday 18th January 2019** and be accompanied by a non-refundable \$15 entry fee. **No entry fees apply to children under 15.**
3. All Floats and individuals must carry their official number in the correct category colour if they wish to be considered for judging. These numbers must be legible and at least **25cm tall and 20 cm wide** with allocated colour letters on a white background and must be displayed on the front of each float, bike or vehicle. Individuals are required to pin or mark their number on their right shoulder. **Entrants are responsible for supplying their own numbers.**
4. Procession Entrants are **not to throw any lollies/items such as flyers** from floats or vehicles. This is a safety issue and you will be held liable if a spectator is injured. **You may instead hand out items from the side of the road.** Procession Entrants are **not to encourage spectators to run on to the road to collect lollies/items when moving vehicles are in the area.**
5. **No charity collections** are permitted except by express written approval from Port Lincoln Tunarama Inc.
6. Any individual may walk with or near a float, but the individual must take care with moving vehicles at all times. All duty of care must be observed.
7. All entries will assemble in **Lincoln Place before 11:30am for a 12 Noon** start Saturday 26th January 2019. The Rotary Club of Port Lincoln will again be marshalling all vehicles. All entries are to follow all directions given by any official marshal, including persons from Police, SES, and Rotary, so as to ensure compliance with all guidelines.
8. Official independent judges and marshals will be strategically placed throughout the procession.
9. All prize winners will be announced on Saturday afternoon on the Festival Stage, please check the programme for time. **Please be sure to have a representative present at this Awards Presentation.** Winners may also collect their prizes from the Tunarama office after the festival for up to 30 days, after which they will be forfeited.
10. All Procession Entrants must ensure they comply with their duty of care at all times and use common sense, so as to not injure or harm any spectator or person in or near the Procession.
11. All Procession Entrants understand that they are entering the Procession at their own risk and by agreeing to sign the attached registration form they acknowledge that Port Lincoln Tunarama Incorporated and any affiliated sponsor shall be indemnified by the applicant against any liability incurred by the nature of their float, costs and expenses incurred by the applicant in defending any proceeding whether civil or criminal in respect of such a liability.
12. ALL vehicles entering the procession must be registered or carry current permits issued for the day.
